FOSTERING the participation of the European regions in the different EU programmes dealing with water issues: This will be the main goal of the seminar *Project Management, Best Practices and European Policy on Water issues*, organized jointly by the European project Interregional Partnership Platform and the European Wateregio Network, that will be held in Brussels next Thursday 19 April.

The **European Wateregio Network** (<u>www.wateregio.net</u>) is a platform of exchange of ideas, experiences and best practices in the field of water management and optimization of water resources. The essence of this network is its methodological approach to the identification of proposals and the partner search in common projects, financed either by the EU or by other bodies, in the field of water. Wateregio partners come from the Valencian Region, Murcia Region (ES), Piemonte, Veneto, Friuli – Venezia Giulia, Lazio, Sardinia (IT), Central Macedonia (GR), Istria (CRO) and Prahova (RO), and there are observers from other Spanish, Italian, Greek and Hungarian regions.

On the other hand, the **Interregional Partnership Platform** is one of the 18 subprojects funded by the Interreg IIIC South Regional Framework Operation Perspective 2007-2013 (www.perspective2013.info). Four regions participate in this initiative: the Valencian Region (ES), Region Centre (FR), Saxony-Anhalt (DE) and Eszak-Alfold (HU). The subproject aims at developing joint projects initiatives on the following themes: water resource management, sustainable transport, automotive clustering, waste management and energy efficiency.
