## Australia

For the third consecutive year a twinning partnership between catchment groups worldwide has produced this colourful Dream River calendar 2011 – testament of true global ecological collaboration, inspired by an art project of the European Rivers Network. For the first time, the Spanish Organisation for the Protection of the Ebro River (Plataforma en defensa de l'Ebre) in Catalonia has joined the partnership between the European Rivers Network in France, the Yadfon Foundation in Thailand, the Southern Gulf Catchments in far north Queensland and the Bulimba Creek Catchment Coordinating Committee in Brisbane, Australia.

Children and teenagers attending schools in these catchment areas have explored their rivers, wetlands or creeks and expressed their vision of a clean and healthy ecosystem in their personal Dream River painting. This international art project seeks to create a ‘sense of place’, the feeling of belonging to a natural place and it belonging to us.

We have much to share and learn from each other – from the history-rich Loire River in France and the life giving Ebro River in Catalonia to the productive estuaries of Southern Thailand; from the isolated Gregory River in north Queensland to the urban catchments of the Brisbane River in Australia. Let’s get inspired by these Dream Rivers and celebrate our cultural and ecological diversity!



## France

Pour la troisième année consécutive, un jumelage de différentes associations de bassins-versants à travers le monde a permis la réalisation de ce calendrier haut en couleurs: “Dream River 2011”.

Preuve d'un véritable partenariat écologique à l'échelle planétaire, ce calendrier est inspiré d'un projet d'art du “Réseau Fleuves Europe” (European Rivers Network).

Pour la première fois, l'organisation espagnole pour la protection de la rivière Ebro (Plataforma en Defensa de l'Ebre) en Catalogne a rejoint le partenariat qui comprend le “Réseau Fleuves Europe” en France, la fondation “Yadfon” en Thaïlande, l'association “The Southern Gulf Catchments” au Nord Queensland et l'association “Bulimba Creek Catchment Coordinating Committee” à Brisbane, Australie.

Les enfants et adolescents scolarisés dans ces bassins versants ont exploré leurs rivières, zones humides ou bien leurs criques et exprimés leur vision d'un écosystème propre, en bonne santé avec leurs peintures de “Rivière de rêve”. Ce projet d'art international cherche à créer un “sens d'affinité”, un sentiment de proximité et d'appartenance à cet environnement exceptionnel, un milieu naturel qui nous appartient aussi à tous.

Nous avons tellement à partager et à apprendre de chacun - de la richesse historique de la rivière du Loire en France et de la vivifiante rivière Ebro en Catalogne aux productives estuaires du sud de la Thaïlande; de l'éloignement de la rivière Gregory dans le Queensland du Nord aux bassins urbains de la rivière de Brisbane en Australie.

Soyons inspiré par nos rivières de rêves et célébrons notre diversité culturelle et écologique !



## Spain

Per tercer any consecutiu, la germanor entre grups de conques fluvials, ha produït aquest atractiu Dream River Calendar 2011 – testimoni de la vertadera col·laboració global i ecològica, i inspirat en un projecte artístic de la European Rivers Network.

Per primer cop, la Plataforma en Defensa de l'Ebre s'ha afegit a aquesta unió entre la European Rivers Network de França, la Yadfon Foundation de Tailàndia, la Southern Gulf Catchments a Queensland del nord i el Bulimba Creek Catchment Coordinating Committee de Brisbane, tots dos a Austràlia.

Joves escolars d'aquestes conques fluvials han explorat els seus respectius rius, aiguamolls o rierols i han expressat la seva visió d'un ecosistema net i saludable en les seves pintures personals Dream River (un riu de somni). Aquest projecte internacional intenta crear una 'Sensació de lloc', és a dir, la sensació de pertànyer a un lloc natural i que aquest, al seu torn, ens pertany.

Tenim molt per compartir i aprendre els uns dels altres – des del Riu Loira a França carregat d'història i el Riu Ebre que dóna vida a les terres catalanes fins als estuaris productius del sud de Tailàndia; de l'aïllat Riu Gregory al nord de Queensland fins a les conques urbanes del riu Brisbane a Austràlia. Deixem-nos inspirar per aquests Dream Rivers i celebrem la nostra diversitat cultural i ecològica!



## Thailand

ปี ค.ศ. 2011 นี้ นับเป็นปีที่สามแล้ว ที่เหล่า พันธมิตรจากลุ่มน้ำต่างๆ ทั่วโลกได้ร่วมมือกัน สร้างสรรค์โครงการปฏิทินแม่น้ำในฝันที่เต็มไปด้วยสีสัน และถือเป็นประจักษ์พยาน ที่แท้จริง แห่งความรวมมือด้านระบบนิเวศทั่วโลก โดยที่ โครงการปฏิทินแม่น้ำในฝันได้รับแรงบันดาลใจ เริ่มแรกมาจากการศึกษาของเครือข่ายแม่น้ำแห่งยูโรป ปีนี้นับเป็นปีแรกที่ องค์กรสเปนเพื่อการปกป้องแม่น้ำเอโนบราซ์ในคากาโนโลเนีย ได้เข้าร่วมเป็นพันธมิตร กับเครือข่ายแม่น้ำแห่งยูโรป มูลนิธิอนุรักษ์ฝัน จ. ตั้ง ประเทศไทย กลุ่มลุ่มน้ำอาว่าใต้ใน แอบตะวันออกไกลແหงรัฐควินสแลนด์ และคณะกรรมการประสานงาน ลุ่มน้ำลุ่มบาร์คี แห่งรัฐวิสเบนประเทศ ออสเตรเลีย

เด็กและวัยรุ่นจาก โรงเรียนต่างๆ ในลุ่มน้ำต่างๆ ก้าว ได้ร่วมกันสำรวจแม่น้ำ พื้นที่ชุมชน ล่าาระ และได้แสดงจินตนาการถึง ระบบนิเวศที่สวยงาม และอุดมสมบูรณ์ผ่านภาพวาดแม่น้ำในฝันของตน โครงการศิลปะระดับนานา ชาตินี้ มุ่งสร้างสรรค์ ความรู้สึกที่ว่าเราต่างเป็นส่วนหนึ่งของธรรมชาติ และธรรมชาติก็เป็นส่วนหนึ่งของเรา

เรายังมีเรื่องราวที่ ต้องแบ่งปันและเรียนรู้จาก กันและกัน จากแม่น้ำลัวร์ที่ รุ่มรวยไปด้วย ประวัติศาสตร์แห่งประเทศไทย ฝรั่งเศส แม่น้ำเอโนบราซ์ แห่ง กำเนิดสูตรชีวิตจากคากาโนโลเนียแห่ง สเปน พื้นที่ลุ่มน้ำอันอุดม สมบูรณ์ทางภาคใต้ของ ประเทศไทย เรื่อยไปจนถึงแม่น้ำเกรเกอร์ กอร์วัน ไกลเพนทางตอนเหนือของรัฐควินสแลนด์ และ ลุ่มน้ำในเขต เมืองอย่างแม่น้ำบริสเบน ประเทศไทย อุสเตรเลีย มาร่วมล้มผัสแรงบันดาลใจ จาก แม่น้ำในฝัน และร่วมเฉลิมฉลองความ หลากหลายทางวัฒนธรรมและระบบนิเวศของโลกเรา ด้วยกันเถิด



## Bulimba Creek Catchment Coordinating Committee (B4C), Australia

B4C is a not-for-profit catchment and Landcare group that works with the community to protect and bring back our natural environment in Bulimba Creek, one of the largest creek catchments in Brisbane. B4C has established a Southside Sustainability Centre – a grass-roots education facility which aims to empower people to become more environmentally aware and live more sustainably. At the centre, people can learn more about sustainable technologies and get involved in hands-on activities in the community gardens and nursery. Volunteers collect and propagate seeds and raise plants which can be purchased by the public or used by B4C in Landcare and rehabilitation work.

Volunteers can also get involved in the development of a native adventure trail, permaculture and different gardening styles, building of native habitats as well as raising of edible bush tucker plants.

B4C seeks to build nature conservation values and get people in the community actively involved in protecting and restoring natural landscapes and habitats.


## Southern Gulf Catchments, Australia

Southern Gulf Catchments is a community-based organisation that aims to protect and restore biodiversity values, arrest land degradation, improve water quality and facilitate coastal and marine management in the southern Gulf of Carpentaria in north-west Queensland. The region has an area of 195,000 square kilometres and comprises the catchments of the Flinders-Cloncurry, Leichhardt and Gregory-Nicholson Rivers, Settlement Creek and Morning Inlet, plus the Wellesley Islands group.

The organisation helps local communities undertake activities ranging from weed control, riparian protection, biodiversity conservation and improved grazing and fire risk management. Southern Gulf Catchments works collaboratively with B4C in Brisbane to provide educational programs for students, setting up Healthy Food Gardens on school grounds and undertaking fish clinics and local excursions to learn more about the ecosystem.




## European Rivers Network, France

The European Rivers Network (ERN) is a not-for-profit NGO and was founded in 1994 by Roberto A. Epple as a project of SOS Loire Vivante, now SOS Loire Vivante – ERN France in cooperation with the International Rivers Network, WWF and other partners. It is a European information and collaboration network of organisations and individuals working in the field of river protection. ERN promotes the sustainable management of rivers and water in opposition to the exploitation, pollution and degradation that has occurred in the past and aims to connect groups, organisations and persons working for the protection of rivers.

ERN is the initiator and coordinator of the Big Jump 2005-2015 – an international river swimming day. This event aims at gaining people's support for restoration efforts for European rivers and wetlands such as the Water Framework Directive of the European Union. Over 350,000 people along 31 river basins in 22 countries have participated since 2005. ERN also organises Youth River Basin Parliaments in European river basins and coordinates international dam decommissioning campaigns. It is the creator of 'Rivers of pictures and flows of words' – an educational art project for young people that promotes environmental awareness around rivers and their catchments, on which this Dream River calendar is based.




## Plataforma en defensa de l'Ebre, Catalonia, Spain

The Organisation for the Protection of the Ebro River (Plataforma en defensa de l'Ebre) has been campaigning to protect Spain's longest river under this name since 2001. However, many volunteers have been involved with the struggle to protect the river, its ecosystems and ways of life since the 1970s. Threats include contamination, over-exploitation and water extraction from the river basin with subsequent negative effects on the quantity and quality of the river's water. The Ebro discharges into the Mediterranean Sea via the beautiful, but delicate Ebro delta. One of the most important natural areas on the Mediterranean coastline, the delta is in a precarious situation due to subsidence, salinisation and regression, all caused or accelerated by poor river flow. The organisation runs public awareness and protest campaigns, undertakes scientific research and fights legal battles. It involves people from all walks of life, but especially youngsters whose future opportunities to live in this area depend on the river being alive and well. The state primary and secondary schools in Tortosa, Catalonia, are all active participants, and they have organised protest days to raise awareness of specific threats. Many youngsters have taken the initiative to celebrate World Water Day and organised clean-up sessions where they collect junk from the river and its banks.

## **Yadfon Foundation Trang, Thailand**

Yadfon Foundation Trang is a grass-roots organisation working with local villagers to conserve the environment and to promote community-based management of natural resources in the Trang province in southern Thailand. When its founder Pisit Charnsnoh set up the organisation in 1985, the environmental problems of seven remote coastal villages in the province were explored. The arrival of big trawlers since the 1960s had depleted the fish habitat. Mangrove forests were logged for the production of charcoal. Villagers were less aware that the destruction of mangrove forests and the destructive fishing practices reduced marine life and led to erosion and silt that choked the coral reef and seagrass beds. Supported by Yadfon, villagers set out to protect mangrove forests, coral reef and seagrass beds, and to reduce destructive fishing practices in protected areas. Not only fish, shellfish, squid, but rare local species like turtles and dugongs have returned to local waterways. Pisit believes that once one ecosystem is in trouble, it affects other connected ecosystems, and environmental conservation can only succeed if local communities, civil servants, academics, media and business work together.

In 1993, Yadfon initiated the networking project 'From the mountain to the sea' by connecting villagers who work together for the long-term sustainable development of local ecosystems and communities in the Trang province.
